Here is a detailed job description:

Manicure Volunteer

Role: As a manicure volunteer, your role is to offer the residents of the Saint-Brigid's Home a relaxing afternoon. Not only do they get pretty nails, but they also get to socialize in a calm environment.

Specific Tasks: You will be asked to arrive 30 minutes before the activity to set up the Kildare Lounge with manicure stations. You will then accompany residents from their rooms to the activity. You will also have to give manicures along with the Community Life Animator. Lastly, at 3:00 residents must be accompanied from the Kildare Lounge back to their rooms.

Skills Needed: Volunteers need to be friendly, kind, and responsible. They must also be able to cut, file, and paint nails properly. Volunteers must respect instructions given to them by the Community Life Animator and/or staff members on the floors. Volunteers must also have had the appropriate training modules for this activity.

Volunteer Responsibilities: You are expected to be punctual, reliable, and organized. You are expected to do the tasks assigned to you.
