Here is a detailed job description:

Mass Volunteer

Role: As a Mass volunteer, your role is to assist the Community Life Animator with the Catholic mass celebration.

Specific Tasks: You will be asked to arrive 30 minutes before the mass to accompany residents from their rooms to the Kildare Lounge, in the Saint-Brigid's Home. You will then assist the mass celebration as a means of ensuring the residents' safety and well-being. Lastly, at 2:30 when the mass is finished, you will help bring the residents back to their rooms.

Skills Needed: Volunteers need to be friendly, kind, and responsible. Volunteers must respect instructions given to them by the Community Life Animator and/or staff members on the floors. An interest in the Christian religion is certainly an asset for this position, but in no way a requirement.

Volunteer Responsibilities: You are expected to be punctual, reliable, and complete the tasks assigned to you.
