Here is a detailed job description:

OKO Volunteer

Role: As an OKO volunteer, your role is to assist the Community Life Animator during the weekly OKO game. You may have to lead the activity, or simply help certain residents play depending on the number of volunteers present.

Specific Tasks: You will be asked to assist residents from their rooms to the Kildare Lounge for the activity. Certain residents require assistance during the game, which volunteers will provide. Also, certain volunteers will be asked to lead the game along with the Community Life Animator. All residents must be assisted back to their rooms at the end of the activity.

Skills Needed: Volunteers need to be friendly, helpful, and outgoing. It is also necessary to know the rules of OKO. Volunteers must respect instructions given to them by the Community Life Animator and/or staff members on the floors. Volunteers must also have had the appropriate training modules this activity.

Volunteer Responsibilities: You are expected to be punctual, reliable, organized, and resourceful. You are expected to do the tasks assigned to you.
