- 400-500 newcomers welcomed by VEQ each year.

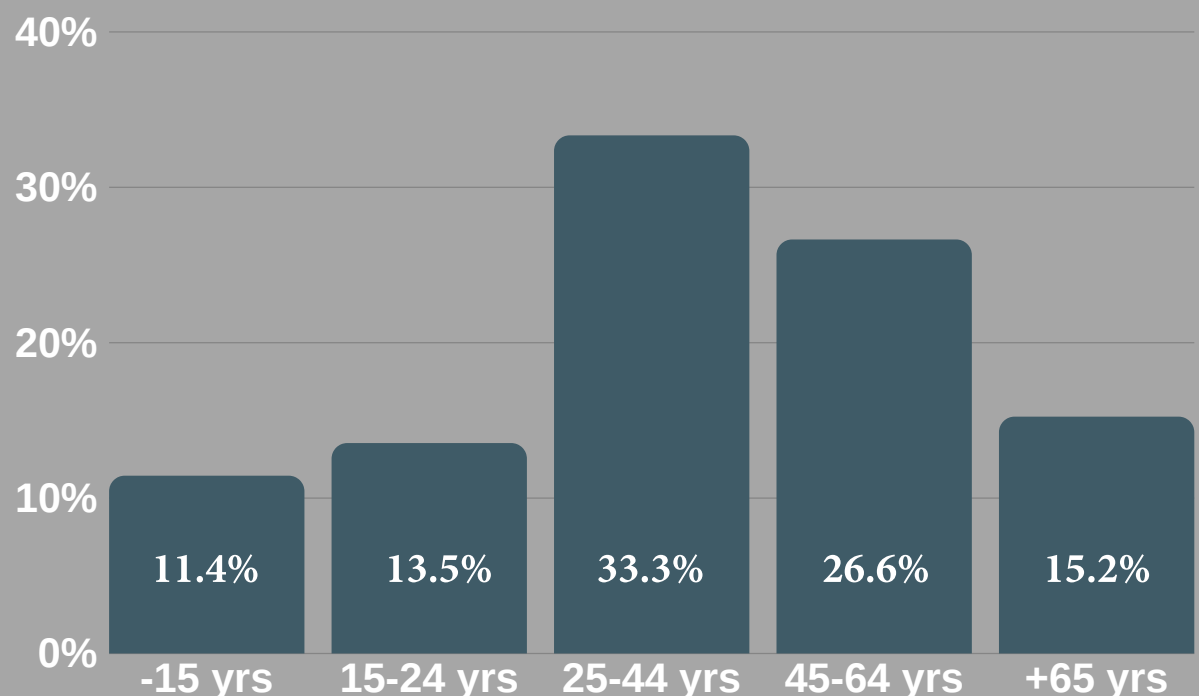

AGE STRUCTURE



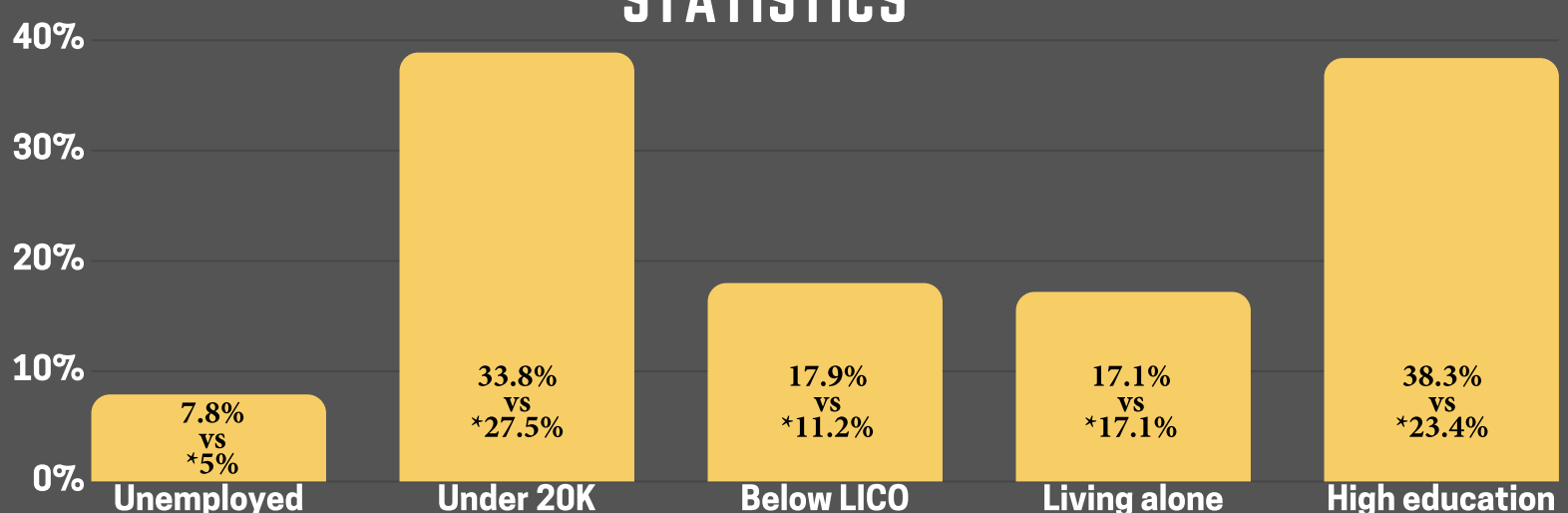
THE LEADERSHIP TABLE
